## 2005 Prix Ars Electronica: Prize Money

Prize money totaling of 117,500 euros (€) will be awarded to the Prix Ars Electronica winners this year. Seven juries made up of international experts have chosen the recipients of six 6 Golden Nicas, 12 Awards of Distinction and 73 Honorary Mentions. The judges have also selected the project that will be produced with financing provided by [the next idea] Art and Technology Grant. Merchandise prizes and special jury prizes are also being awarded.
