(Linz, October 15, 2010) "Sonic Intermedia" is a new concert series featuring contemporary computer music. It is produced jointly by the Ars Electronica Center and the Anton Bruckner Private University. Inaugural guests are Simon Waters of the University of East Anglia in Norwich, UK and several doctoral candidates at that school. Concertgoers will be treated to an extraordinary audiovisual composition consisting of real-time and non-real-time computer music accompanied by impressive visuals in 16x9-meter format. The following day, Simon Waters will elaborate on the theoretical and conceptual aspects of the music in a speech at the Anton Bruckner Private University. "Sonic Intermedia" is an initiative of composers/media artists Andreas Weixler and Se-Lien Chuang, as well as Ars Electronica Artistic Director Gerfried Stocker.
