Barbara Hinterleitner and Michael Gugler from UNION Skydiving Club Linz will present breathtaking videos of their flights above town, thrilling footage of mid-air formations and exciting sequences shot at indoor wind tunnels in which air currents make it possible to simulate real jumps. Plus, there'll be a screening of an absolutely over-the-top 3D clip designed to deliver the adrenalin kick that is the essence of this fascinating sport.

Founded in 1967, UNION Skydiving Club Linz is the largest association of its kind in Austria. Its members include multiple national and state titleholders in just about every discipline in this sport. These men and women frequently take part in attempts to set all kinds of new records. The UNION Skydiving Club Linz trains about 50 new parachutists every year.
