(Linz, October 12, 2015) This coming weekend, Saturday & Sunday, October 17-18, the Ars Electronica Center will focus on the fascinating realm inside the human body. Visitors to the new Deep Space 8K will have an opportunity to behold the anatomy theater of the future and get close-up, layer-by-layer looks at organs, muscles, bones, the cardiovascular system and the body's network of nerves. Dr. Franz Fellner of Linz General Hospital and Klaus Engel of Siemens Health Care will already be getting things started on Thursday at 8 PM with a presentation of new forms of three-dimensional anatomical visualization that deliver photorealistic images of the human body. There'll be a repeat performance on Saturday at 3 PM. On Sunday at 3 PM, Dr. Andreas Shamiyeh of Linz General Hospital will narrate a fascinating tour of the digestive system.
