Deep Space for Kids / Saturday & Sunday, December 17-18 / 11 AM, 12:30, 3:30 & 4:30 PM

SILENCE? You've got to be kidding! In Deep Space 8K, kids are encouraged to give free rein to their playfulness. The lineup of fun & games includes a walk on the Moon, horseplay in a comic aquarium and a journey of discovery in subterranean Rome, a mysterious realm of mines, canals and secret temples!
